School Disco

We are changing the way that we run our school disco in school.

All EYFS and KS1 children should pay for their disco tickets before Tuesday 16th so that we know the number of children who are wanting to attend. School will keep a register of who has paid. The cost for each child will be £2.50. KS2 children can pay on the door.



On the day of the disco (Tuesday 16^{th} July) KS1 & EYFS children will bring their disco clothes and any spending money to school. The children will get changed for the disco at school and school staff will take them to the disco and supervise them.

KS1 / EYFS Disco will run from 3.15pm - 4.15pm.

Parents do not need to attend as school staff will be supervising.

Please collect your child from their usual classroom door at 4.15pm.

4.30pm - 5.30pm KS2 Disco

KS2 teachers will be at the hall door to welcome the children and take payment. Parents do not need to stay as school staff will be supervising the children.

Children can bring in their own money to spend.

5.30pm KS2 Children to be collected from their classrooms.

Y6 can only walk home on their own if they have had special permission from parents as it will be 5.30pm (if we have not heard from Y6 parents, then the children will need to be collected by an adult).
