School Day Timings

School opens at 8.50am and registers are completed by 9am. Please ensure children are on time so their morning tasks can be started promptly. The morning tasks, which are part of the curriculum, are organised to settle children into the day. Children enter and leave school via their classroom fire door. Year 6 children are able to walk to and from school without a parent if written permission is provided. Reading and Homework

Reading books and records should come home daily. Please ensure your child reads and discusses their book at least 5 times a week, and log all reading in reading records to ensure your child/children achieve the HIGH 5 READER AWARD each week! We strongly value the importance of reading as studies have shown that daily reading for pleasure makes a big difference to children's educational performance. Homework challenges will be sent home this week with a menu of activities to further develop and embed the children's knowledge relating to their current learning in school. We really love receiving their work to share with the class and put on display.


Your child will receive a list of weekly spellings to learn at home, as well as in school (the spelling lists are also available on the school website). Please help your child to learn their spellings, ready for their test on a Monday morning.



Children are also expected to use Reading Plus at least twice a week at home, to ensure they complete the 5 stories and 1 vocabulary challenge which they are set each week; the majority of the tasks are completed in school. Times Table Rockstars should also be used regularly at



home to support children in practising their times tables recall. All children in Years 5 and 6 should be able to confidently recall facts up to 12×12 , along with corresponding division facts. Please see your child's reading diary for their log in details.



Our Topic

Our whole school theme this term is 'Changes Over Time'. The topic mat, also sent home along with this letter, shares the knowledge, vocabulary and key texts for this term. We will be learning about Evolution and Electricity in Science lessons and World War Two in History lessons, comparing similarities and differences between life then and now. We are launching our history topic with a visit from the author of our class text MY FRIEND THE ENEMY (linked to our WW2 learning) next Monday 9th September. Dan Smith will share a presentation with the children about the inspiration for his book, followed by a question

and answer session! We can't wait for this fantastic opportunity!

Science and Forest School



We have 2 science topics this term: Evolution & Inheritance and Electricity. Mrs Goss will be teaching Evolution and Inheritance through her Forest School

sessions with Year 6 in the first half term and then Year 5 in the second half. Electricity will be taught in class for the year group not doing Forest School. Learning about electricity and how to make circuits work is always such fun and the children enjoy the great practical sessions!
