A habitat provides food, water and shelter for the animals and plants that live there. Living things need food, water and air – they grow, reproduce, make waste and sense things. Food chains always start with a plant. Some things are alive. Some things were alive and are now dead. Some things have never been alive at all – these are non-living things.
