<p>SCIENCE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fossils provide information about living things that inhabited earth millions of years ago. Living things produce offspring that can vary and are not identical to their parents. Living things adapt to survive in their environment- survival of the fittest. Species may have evolved from a common ancestor but variation occurs due to environmental factors. Adaptation can lead to the evolution. of species



HISTORY - World War II	
garrison	A military outpost where troops are stationed to provide protection to an area
battalion	A large body of troops or army.
evacuee	A person sent away from a dangerous place.
rationing	Allowing people to have a fixed amount of something.
allies	Friendly nations which join sides and unite during war.

<p>HISTORY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Second world war began in 1939 when Germany invaded Poland Children from larger cities in England were sent to smaller towns and villages such as Ripon because their homes were being bombed by the enemy. Ripon was a Garrison town where soldiers trained and formed in battalions in the summer of 1939. Rationing was introduced in 1940 to provide small amounts of certain foods such as sugar and chocolate. France, Russia and later the USA were allies of Great Britain, which lead to Germany surrendering in 1945.

RE - Stories of Hinduism	
reincarnation	The belief that after death, the soul is born again in a new body.
dharma	A code of living that emphasizes good conduct and morality which Hindus aim for.
moksha	The ultimate goal of liberation from the cycle of birth, death, and rebirth.
puja	An act of worship performed to honour and show devotion to a god or goddess.
mantra	A sacred word, sound, or sound repeated in prayers and meditation to aid concentration and spiritual.

Reincarnation is being born again after death. Prince Bharata's attachment to a deer led him to be reborn as one. Lord Krishna teaches that the soul never dies but is reborn many times.
