Reading

We strongly believe that reading for pleasure plays a vital role in children's success in all aspects of learning and later life. Therefore, we insist that children read to an adult at home at least 5 times a week and we celebrate this regular reading with our High 5 Reader competition. Please continue to sign the reading record to indicate every time your child has read. Reading records will be checked weekly to record and celebrate High 5 Readers! It is important that children have their reading books and records in school everyday.



This term's homework challenges have been shared along with this letter. Please encourage your child/children to complete all of the challenges throughout the term as they will enhance and consolidate their learning in school. The challenges can be completed in any order and brought into school as they are completed to display in the classrooms. We love to receive all your great work!



Reading Plus or Reading Eggs should continue to be used at home as often as possible to further support your child/children's reading. It has been proven that children make more rapid progress with their reading when accessing the program more regularly.

Times table Rockstars, which is an individualised program to support children in practising their tables, should also be used regularly at home to ensure children can confidently recall multiplication and division facts up to 12 \times 12. By the end of Year 4, children are expected to be able to instantly recall all table facts up to 12 \times 12. Don't forget to complete your monthly Gig and keep going into Studio to get your rock status.



Curriculum

The theme of this term's topic is Diversity. In Geography lessons, we will be learning about Ghana, focussing on types of settlements, land use, farming and Fair Trade as well as looking at the affects the different climate has. We will be learning about States of Matter and Rocks in Science lessons. The topic mat provides the knowledge, vocabulary and key texts for this term. Please encourage your children to share this with you at home.

Our Class Texts

This term, we will be reading the text "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory". Charlie and the Chocolate Factory explores themes of kindness, hope and family as well as family and greed. The book is about the adventures of Charlie Bucket inside the chocolate factory of the eccentric chocolatier Willy Wonka where we will explore the idea that a person will in time be on the receiving end of the way they treat others. This is an exciting text and is also a Year 4 Recommended read.
