Deciduous trees: lose their leave in Autumn	Evergreen plants: do not lose their leaves in Autumn	Seasonal Changes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are 4 seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter in a Year. • Day and night length changes because of the earth tilting closer or further away from the sun. Colder weather comes in Autumn and Winter. • Warmer weather comes in Spring and Summer. • The weather and light affect what happens to deciduous trees and plants 	Plants <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deciduous trees, include Oak, Beech, Hazel, Birch and Rowan. • Evergreen plants include Holly, Ivy and Pine trees. • Spring flowers include Daffodils, Tulips, Crocuses, Daisies and hyacinths. • Trees have roots (which are underground) a trunk, branches and leaves. • Plants have roots, a stem, leaves and flowers.
