
MOORSIDE PRIMARY SCHOOL AND NURSERY NEWSLETTER

Next week we are having a safety week in school.... It is Safer Internet Day on Tuesday, but we are also learning about:


- Road safety (including being safe on bikes)

I hope that you all have a relaxing weekend ahead and keep warm!!!


