Natural materials include rocks and wood. Man-made materials include glass and plastic.Most materials have more than one property. They may be strong or weak, heavy or light, or shiny or dull.Materials which are durable will last a long time without breaking.Some materials can be changed by squishing, bending, twisting or stretching them.

RE		RE: Christian Rites of Passage <ul style="list-style-type: none">A rite of passage is an event that marks an important stage of someone's life. This can be religious or non-religious.Most Christian families will baptise their new baby. This is called a christening where the baby is welcomed into the Christian church.For Catholics, Holy Communion is a special event where Christians receive bread and wine.A Christian marriage ceremony is an event where two people agree to spend their lives together.Christians believe dying is the final rite of passage. A funeral is an event where family and friends join together to remember the person who died and give thanks for their life.
